Team Leaders' meeting: The team leaders' meeting will be on Friday at 15.45 at the pool restaurant.

Coach app: All team leaders will get a mail with the login to the coach app

a standard web browser in your computer, tablet or phone.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals to timed finals on Friday should be made Friday at 14.30 hours

at the latest. this is done from the coach app or by mail:

For the prelim and timed finals on Saturday and Sunday at the latest 30 minutes after the end of finals the day before, this is done from the app or

in the competition office.

Withdrawals from prelim to final should be made at the latest 30 minutes

after each event in the competition office.

Finals: Distances up to 200 m are swum in A- and B-finals, distances of 400m in A-

finals only. The session on Friday evening contains the timed finals for 400

IM and 1500 m Freestyle.

For the 800 m Freestyle, the last heat is in the evening session and the second fastest heat is according to the list of events. If there are more than two heats then the remaining heats will be after the last event of prelims.















Relays: Team formations should be made in the app or on paper at the competition

office at latest 1 hour before the start of the final session on both Saturday

and Sunday.

Call room: Call room will be just beside the pool deck. All heats during the final

sessions will go through call room to enter the pool deck.

Start procedure: For all heats during prelims, after finished race the swimmers stay in pool

by the closest lane rope. After the start of the next heat the swimmers leave the pool. This procedure will only be applied during the prelims.

Prize money: Able-bodied Swimmers

The winners of each individual event will be awarded SEK 1 000 and

Winners of relay event will be awarded SEK 2 000.

The four best performances (FINA points), men and women respectively, will be awarded 1st SEK 20 000, 2nd 15 000, 3rd 10 000, 4th 5 000. One

event per swimmer, results from finals only.

Para Swimmers

The three best performances (WPS points), men and women collectively,

will be awarded 1st SEK 3 000, 2nd 2 000, 3rd 1 000.

One event per swimmer.

Best team: Best team wins a price worth SEK 5 000. Points to the 16 best swimmers of

each event 18, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Accreditation: Swimmers entered in individual events will be issued an accreditation

automatically, others have to apply here: https://response.questback.com/idrott/sgp20

Accreditations are received in the competition office.
